Key Features

- Available in four sizes, with double doors on models 2–4.
- Single-wall body and door constructed with 3mm solid steel. Doors have a total thickness of 52mm and open to 180°.
- Secured by three-way boltwork, locking at the top, bottom and side of the door. All bolts are chrome-plated and 20mm in diameter.
- Doors also fitted with relocking device to give additional protection against attempted forced entry.
- Key lock (Class A) fitted as standard.
- Anchor points in the base allow the cabinet to be fixed to the floor.
- All cabinets have a light-grey, powder-coated finish, suitable for any office space (RAL 7035).

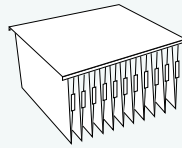


Electronic Lock

ForceGuard can be fitted with a double-bitted key lock, a 3-wheel combination lock or a high-security electronic lock as the primary locking option.

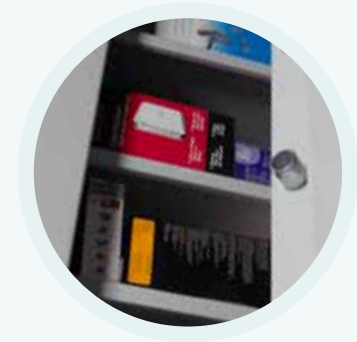
